Subject

The digital transformation changes the perception of mobility, from autonomous systems to interconnected mobility. This affects the (infra-)structure, which determines the prerequisites of mobility, as well as the processes of producing vehicles and other goods, transporting passengers or products, moving capital, and exploiting data.

The MIGW conference is an interdisciplinary conference which brings together economy and logistics, information technology and engineering.
